Introduction:

ASRLM:

NRLM is being implemented in Assam by **Assam State Rural Livelihoods Mission Society (ASRLMS)** with the objectives laid by NRLM for enhancing the social and economic empowerment of rural poor of Assam. It is an independent and autonomous body under Society registration Act XXI of 1860, and established by Panchayat and Rural Development Department, Government of Assam on 11th Nov'2011.

Vision and Mission of ASRLM:

Vision

ASRLMS envisions that each poor family should have an annual income of Rs. 50,000 per annum.

Mission

To reduce poverty by enabling the poor households to access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities, resulting in appreciable improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis, through building strong grassroots institutions of the poor.

Objectives:

1. To create an enabling and pro poor policy environment.
2. To contribute to the lives of the rural poor of the state through economic empowerment of the rural poor women and fostering strong, self-managed grass root institutions.
3. To evolve strategies and approaches for the empowerment of the poor through social mobilization and institution building for community participation.
4. To build support and service structures for providing social and technical guidance to the poor in their overall social process and livelihood development.

5. To strengthen and form producer co-operatives/collectives around key commodities, non-farm products and services and expanding people's participation in existing commodity co-operatives and producer collectives.
6. To organize forum for show casing and supporting various innovations and experimentation with new ideas both for social service delivery and livelihoods promotion.
7. To support PRI in becoming more responsive and effective in last mile delivery of public services and entitlements of the poor.
8. To providing skill development training to rural youth for wage employment and self - employment.

Activities Undertaken

1. Data entry of work demand for an individual work under MGNREGA.
2. Visited Gwjwn VO for general meeting.
3. Visited the CLF office along with BPM and visited Mustard seed production mill.
4. Non- farm Survey.
5. Attended non-farm meeting at Purani Goraimari, Udalguri.
6. To take information through telephonic conversation from the CLF about their mustard seed plantation plan.
7. Visited Janapriya farm.
8. To make a list about mustard seed production plan.
9. Attended meeting about Block level TOT training under Assam State Rural Livelihood Mission.
10. Attended the training of SHG's i.e practical like double digging, Zero tillage, Vermi-compost etc.

The one month internship under ASRLM was great. It has helped the trainee to get closely engaged with the organization work and the staff.
