3.4.1 Extension projects 2022-23

The institute undertook the following extension projects during the academic year, 2022-23:

1. IQAC facilitated *ASER-2022 survey* in Ahmednagar district on 14-18 September 2022. Altogether 30 villages were selected from all 14 blocks of Ahmednagar District. The Annual Status of Education Report (ASER) is an annual, citizen-led household survey that aims to understand whether children in rural India are enrolled in school and whether they are learning conducted by Pratham Foundation. Nation-wide ASER surveys provided representative estimates of the enrolment status of children aged 3-16 and the basic reading and arithmetic levels of children aged 5-16 at the national, state and district level.
2. *Shelter project*: CSRD in collaboration with Ahmednagar Municipal Corporation, under National Urban Livelihood Mission, has been running a Shelter Home project for the urban homeless since February, 2018. The agreement of project is renewed annually and has been continued for the year 2022-23. Under this project a temporary night shelter is provided to urban homeless at Katwan Khandoba. The shelter home is developed with all the necessary facilities like separate beds, light, fan, toilet and bathrooms have been provided. CCTV is installed in the premises to provide security to them along with the full-time security guard is appointed at Katwan Khandoba. Ahmednagar Municipal Corporation is providing operations and maintenance cost along with honorarium of the staff. Major activities carried out during 2022-23 included provision of night shelter to 190 people, identification 109 new homeless for night shelter, individual counselling to the urban homeless, conducting survey of homeless persons, awareness campaign, organization of regular health check camps, health and medical support to 169 persons, special programmes and recreational activities, case management by networking with different govt. offices and agencies, coordination with family persons for rehabilitation process, provision of livelihood to 7 persons, family based rehabilitation to 26 persons, and assistance to 22 beneficiaries to get government documents/identity cards.
3. Special Swachha Bharat Abhiyan at Ahmednagar fort was held on 11 September 2022 by NSS student volunteers
4. Distribution of clothes to migrant labours was held on 25th September 2022 by NSS student volunteers
5. Awareness on the need and the importance of polio vaccination along with administering polio vaccine drops in urban and rural communities was conducted on 2 to 4 November 2022

6. Rally on Road Safety campaign in collaboration with PWD Department Govt. of Maharashtra was organized on 17th Jan. 2023.
7. On the occasion of 128th Birth Anniversary of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar the Institute in collaboration with Social Welfare Department, Ahmednagar organized 8 extension programmes in several villages of Ahmednagar block under the Samajik Nyay Parvah on 01st April to 01st May 2023: - Organized mental health awareness and health check-up camp for senior citizens on 13th April 2023 at Bhingar; Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan was organized on 12th April 2023 at Jijamata School; Blood Donation and Health Checkup camp was organized on 13th April 2023 at Takli Kazi Village; Samata Rally was organized on 14th April 2023; Celebration of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Jayanti was held on 14th April 2023 at the Institute; Awareness on Govt. Scheme and Skill Training was organized on 20th April 2023 at Nehru Colony, Bhingar; Eye Checkup camp was organized on 20th April 2023 at Shelter home; District Level Essay writing and Elocution Competition was organized on 24th April 2023.
8. IQAC facilitated 7 days' residential rural camp from 17th to 23rd January 2023 in Sonewadi Village of Ahmednagar district. During this camp the students undertook Shramadan to repair the water harvesting structures built in the village, conducted social awareness campaigns on tree plantation, sanitation, women empowerment, children's education, HIV/AIDS. Special guidance sessions were organised for the students as well as the villagers with the support of expert resource persons from various fields. 104 students participated in the residential camp. About 100 youth from the village took part in various activities of the camp.
9. IQAC facilitated exposure visits of the students: 68 MSW second year students accompanied by 4 faculty members participated in study tour to BCM college, Kottayam, Kerala to attend the 20th Samanwaya, the International Conference on Child Rights and the students meet on 1-9 March 2023. During the international conference 10 students and two faculty members of the Institute presented papers, two students presented posters, one faculty member moderated several sessions, students presented cultural program (Maharashtra darshan). The students also participated in street play competition and quiz competition. The MSW I study tour was organized at Nashik on 29-31 March 2023. All together 101 students attended the study tour along with 3 faculty members. They attended national symposium on SDG and gender diversity, inclusion for development, at Social Work College, Nashik. The organizations visited during the study tour were Sahyadri farmers producer company ltd. Mohadi, tal. Dindori, Mohadi village, Child line Nashik, Abhivyakti and Prabodhini Vidya Mandir.
10. IQAC facilitated the National Service Scheme (NSS) Office to organise various student focussed activities throughout the year, such as, Azadi Ka Amrut Movosthav and Swaraj Mostav's inaugural program at Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU), organised by the Department of NSS on 9 August 2022,
11. Har Ghar Tiranga program from 9 to 15 August 2022
12. Participation of the Red Ribbon Club members of the NSS volunteers in a district level quiz competition organised by Ahmednagar District Hospital on 18 October 2022

13. IQAC facilitated the regular field work extension programme of MSW course under which the students visited developmental organisations, conducted outreach activities in social welfare, service and development sectors in 15 agencies including local schools (ZP and Municipal), 10 urban slum communities, 13 village communities, 4 family and child welfare agencies and 5 medical and psychiatric settings including hospitals.

a) Observation visits:

As a part of MSW syllabus observation visits to development organizations, industries and communities are organized during the first semesters from 12th to 17th Sep. 2022.
